Self-Care for Grief

First Steps: Tremendous stress and sorrow are often experienced during this time. Please remember to take a moment and care for yourself if you are overwhelmed. Here are a few suggestions to guide you through this process:

1. Reach out to family, friends, and/or clergy for support and comfort.
2. Select a mortuary to help make arrangements for the funeral and your loved one's remains. You may need to call several funeral homes to find the best fit and pricing. The funeral director will arrange the transport of your loved one's remains back to the funeral home following an examination. They can also assist with your chosen method of final disposition, including cremation and burial.
3. Start a file or folder to keep all paperwork and information that will be shared with you.
4. Keep track of all business cards given to you by law enforcement, county medical examiner, ambulance, and funeral home personnel.
5. Finally, remember that grief takes a lot of time to get through the shock and all the emotions. Take one day at a time. Remember that your grief is a reflection of how much you loved your lost family member. Don't be afraid to use resources available to you in your community. Here are a few:
