6	MS. CANDACE COOPER: OKAY, WE ARE ON THE RECORD OF THE DEATH OF ANDRES
7	GUARDADO, I WOULD LIKE EVERYONE THAT IS PRESENT TO TURN OFF ANY CELL
8	PHONES OR RECORDING DEVICES. THIS MATTER IS A CORONER'S INQUEST INTO THE
9	DEATH OF AN INDIVIDUAL. MY NAME IS CANDACE COOPER, I AM THE HEARING
10	OFFICER FOR THIS MATTER E. I HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED BY THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY
11	MEDICAL EXAMINER CORONER TO CONDUCT THE REQUEST. THE CORONER MY CONDUCT A
12	FORMER INQUIRY AT ANY TIME THERE'S THE DEATH OF AN INDIVIDUAL IN THE
13	COUNTY, PURSUANT TO COUNTY CODE 4971.6. AS A MATTER OF PUBLIC POLICY, AN
14	INQUEST MAY BE HELD WHEN THERE IS A DIRECT CONNECTION BETWEEN A LAW
15	ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN THE COUNTY AND THE DEATH OF A HUMAN BEING. THIS IS
16	NOT AN ADVERSARIAL PROCEEDING. UNDER CALIFORNIA LAW, THE DECISION AT THE
17	END OF AN INQUEST SHOULD BE INADADMISSIBLE IN ANY CIVIL OR CRIMINAL
18	PROCEEDING, PURSUANT TO 27502.2, BUT IT DOES NOT MEAN THE SWORN STATEMENT
19	OF A WITNESS IN AN INQUEST IS INADMISSIBLE IN ANY SUBSEQUENT PROCEEDING.
20	IT IS DESIGNED TO ENSURE THAT THERE IS INDEPENDENT REVIEW IN THE FINDINGS
21	PURSUANT TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES AND DEATH PURSUANT TO MR. GUARDADO. THEY DO
22	NOT MAKE REFERENCE TO CIVIL OR CRIMINAL RESPONSIBILITY ON THE PART OF THE
23	DECEASED OR ANY OTHER PERSON. GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 27.505. THE
24	LEGISLATIVE FUNCTIONS PERFORMED BY OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES ARE NOT
25	A PART OF THE INQUEST PROCESS. SEE GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 27.491. IT IS
26	OPEN TO VIEWING ON THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY WEBSITE BROWSER. INDIVIDUALS AR





1	NOT ALLOWED TO SPEAK FROM THE SUPERVISOR'S HEARING ROOM DURING TESTIMONY.
2	DUE TO THE RISE OF COVID-19 CASES IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY AND IN ORDER TO
3	COMPLY WITH PUBLIC HEALTH SAFETY GUIDELINES, I AM LIMITING IN PERSON
4	ATTENDANCE TO ESSENTIAL STAFF, WITNESSES, AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC UP TO
5	THE CAPACITY OF THE ROOM APPLYING CURRENT COVID-19 GUIDELINES.
6	ACCORDINGLY, ALL OTHER INDIVIDUALS ARE WELCOME TO ATTEND THE INQUEST
7	PROCEEDING BY WATCHING VIA THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY CHANNEL. ALL PERSONS
8	ENTERING THE HEARING ROOM ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A FACE MASKS OVER THEIR
9	NOSE AND MOUTH AND REMAIN A DISTANCE OF SIX FEET FROM OTHER INDIVIDUALS. I
10	HAVE MY FACE MASK IN ADDITION TO THE SHIELD, AS SOON AS I FINISH THESE
11	OPENING REMARKS, I WILL RESUME THE WEARING OF THE MASK. IT IS A LITTLE TOO
12	HARD TO SPEAK. AND THE EXPLANATION OF THE INQUEST PROCESS, BEFORE WE MOVE
13	INTO THE EVIDENCE PHASE OF THE HEARING, I'M GOING TO EXPLAIN WHAT IS GOING
14	TO HAPPEN IN TODAY'S HEARING. FIRST OF ALL, WE HAVE A COURT REPORTER THAT
15	IS TAKING DOWN EVERYTHING WE SAY TODAY SO A PROPER PUBLIC RECORD CAN BE
16	MADE, REQUIRED BY GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 27.502. A TRANSCRIPT OF THE
17	WITNESS'S TESTIMONY SHALL BE FILED WITHIN TEN DAYS FOLLOWING THE INQUEST,
18	EITHER WITH THE CORONER'S OFFICE OR COUNTY CLERK AS DETERMINED BY THE
19	BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. I WILL CALL THE APPROPRIATE WITNESSES AND WILL
20	DIRECT ALL QUESTIONS AT THE WITNESSES. BECAUSE I AM ALSO GOING TO BE
21	ASSESSING THE WITNESSES AND TAKING NOTES DURING TESTIMONY IN ORDER TO
22	REACH MY FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS, I HAVE ASKED THAT COUNTY COUNSEL
23	ASSIST IN THE QUESTIONING OF THE WITNESSES. I HAVE CONFERRED WITH COUNTY
24	COUNSEL IN ADVANCE OF TODAY'S HEARING, REVIEWED THE PROPOSED LINES OF
25	OHESTIONS AND DECIDED AND ACTUALLY AGREED IN MY CASE ON THE





1	APPROPRIATENESS OF THE QUESTIONS. DURING THE EXAMINATIONS, I RETAIN THE
2	AUTHORITY TO ASK FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS OR DIRECT COUNTY COUNSEL TO FOCUS
3	THEIR LINE OF QUESTIONING TO A SPECIFIC ISSUE. THE GUARDADO FAMILY AND THE
4	L. A. S. D. HAVE BEEN GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO SUBMIT POTENTIAL QUESTIONS
5	FOR MY REVIEW. I HAVE REVIEWED THE PROPOSED QUESTIONS AND I WILL BE, I
6	HAVE ALLOWED THOSE TO BE ASKED THAT I DEEM MATERIAL AND REVEL LEVANT TO
7	THE PROCEEDINGS TODAY AND DON'T DUPLICATE QUESTIONS THAT WERE DECIDED TO
8	BE ASKED. IN WHY SUBMITTED QUESTIONS WERE NOT POSED, I WILL NOT ADDRESS
9	WHY I ELECTED TO ACCEPT OR REJECT A SUBMITTED PROPOSED QUESTION. MY
10	ULTIMATE DECISION IS GOING TO BE BASED ON THE EVIDENCE RECEIVED AT THE
11	INQUEST, THAT EVIDENCE IS GOING TO INCLUDE THE TESTIMONY PRESENTED AS WELL
12	AS DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE RECEIVED, WHICH INCLUDES DOCUMENTS, PHOTOGRAPHS,
13	REPORTS, AND OTHER RECORDS. I AM THE SOLE DECIDER OF THE RELEVANCE AND THE
14	ADMISSIBILITY OF THE EVIDENCE OFFERED AND I WILL USE BOTH STANDARD AND
15	HISTORICAL RULES OF EVIDENCE AND ADMISSIBILITY IN MAKING THAT
16	DETERMINATION. HOWEVER, IT IS MY INTENTION TO RECEIVE ALL REASONABLY-
17	AVAILABLE EVIDENCE FROM WITNESSES WHO WERE AT THE SCENE OF THE INCIDENT,
18	IMMEDIATELY BEFORE, DURING, OR IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE EVENTS. I WILL ALSO
19	RECEIVE THE EVIDENCE REGARDING THE DECEASED. AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE
20	EVIDENCE, I WILL BE TAKING A RECESS OR ADJOURN IF THE CASE MAY BE, AS
21	NECESSARY TO REVIEW THE EVIDENCE AND TO MAKE A DECISION. MY TASK IN THIS
22	INQUEST IS TO DETERMINE WHICH OF THE FOLLOWING FOUR POTENTIAL MODES OF
23	DEATH APPLIES TO THE DEATH OF MR. GUARDADO: I AM REQUIRED TO RENDER A
24	DECISION, SETTING FORTH, ONE, THE NAME OF THE DECEDENT, TWO, THE TIME AND
25	PLACE OF DEATH, THREE, THE MEDICAL CAUSE OF DEATH, AND FOUR, WHETHER THE





1	DEATH WAS BY NATURAL CAUSES, SUICIDE, ACCIDENT, OR THE HANDS OF ANOTHER
2	PERSON, OTHER THAN BY ACCIDENT. IN DETERMINING THE MANNER OF DEATH, THERE
3	ARE ONLY FOUR POSSIBLE MODES OF DEATH DEFINED AS FOLLOWS. ONE, NATURAL
4	CAUSES, EXAMPLES BEING HEART ATTACK, STROKE, OLD AGE, ETC. DEATH BY
5	NATURAL CAUSES IS A DEATH ARISING FROM AN ACTIVE NATURE AS OPPOSED TO ONE
6	THAT IS ARTIFICIALLY INDUCED. TWO, ACCIDENT, FOR EXAMPLE, THERE IS NO
7	INTENT, THERE IS AN ACCIDENT, LIKE A CAR CRASH. DEATH BY ACCIDENT CAN
8	REFER TO A VARIETY OF UNFORESEEN OR UNINTENTIONAL EVENTS, SOME OF THOSE
9	INVOLVE NATURAL PHENOMENON, SUCH AS DEATH BY FIRE, FLOOD, OR EARTHQUAKE,
10	IN WHICH CASE NO HUMAN AGENCY IS INVOLVED. ANOTHER TYPE OF ACCIDENT IS THE
11	KIND THAT RESULTS FROM HUMAN ACTS OR CONDUCT. DEATH BY ACCIDENT WHERE A
12	HUMAN AGENCY IS INVOLVED IS BEST DEFINED AS THE UNINTENDED OR UNEXPECTED
13	RESULT OF HUMAN ACCIDENT, OR HUMAN CONDUCT. THE TERM ACCIDENT AS IT
14	APPLIED IN THESE PROCEEDINGS IS AN UNFORESEEN EVENT, MISFORTUNE, LOSS,
15	ACT, OR OMISSION. SUICIDE IS THE TAKING OF ONE'S OWN LIFE, PURPOSEFULLY,
16	OR TAKING ONE'S OWN LIFE OR TO PURPOSEFULLY CAUSE ANOTHER TO TAKE ONE'S
17	LIFE. SUICIDE IS DEFINED AS AN INTENTIONAL ACT OF SELF DESTRUCTION BY
18	WHICH ONE WITH SUFFICIENT TOUCH WITH REALITY UNDERSTANDS THE NATURE OF HIS
19	OR HER ACT. THE FACT ANOTHER PERSON, INCLUDING A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER,
20	ACTED AS THE INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE DECEASED SUBJECT'S DEATH DOES NOT
21	PRECLUDE A FINDING OF SUICIDE WHEN THE SUBJECT INTENDED TO PRECIPITATE THE
22	USE OF DEADLY FORCE AGAINST HIMSELF OR HERSELF. THE FOURTH IS AT THE HANDS
23	OF ANOTHER, OTHER THAN BY ACCIDENT. THIS WOULD BE THE PERSON'S
24	PURPOSEFULLY KILLED, FOR EXAMPLE, SHOT, ETC. DEATH AT THE END HANDS OF
25	AMORUED DECIDES ACCIDENT IS SELE EVOADTICILADTODY. IT IS AN INTENTIONAL



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- 1 ACTS THAT CAUSES THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON, OR INTENTIONAL OMISSION TO
- 2 ACT THAT DIRECTLY CAUSES THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON. I WILL DETERMINE THE
- 3 MANNER OR MODE OF DEATH BY A MORE LIKELY TRUE THAN NOT TRUE STANDARD. THIS
- 4 MEANS THAT, IN EXAMINING ALL THE EVIDENCE, I WILL DECIDE WHICH MODE OR
- 5 MANNER OF DEATH OF THE FOUR LISTED CAUSES IS THE MOST LIKELY TO BE TRUE.
- 6 ASSISTING ME IN THE PROCESS ARE THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS FROM THE COUNTY
- 7 COUNSEL WHO WILL BE ACTING AS EXAMINERS TODAY, I WILL INTRODUCE THEM BY
- 8 NAME AND THEN WE WILL MOVE INTO TAKING OF TESTIMONY. FIRST, MR. JOSEPH
- 9 LANGTON, PRINCIPAL DEPUTY COUNTY COUNSEL. ALEXANDRA ZUIDERWEG, IF I AM
- 10 PRONOUNCING THAT CORRECTLY, SENIOR DEPUTY COUNTY COUNSEL. AND MICHAEL
- 11 MILLER, DEPUTY COUNTY COUNSEL. NOW, WE WILL MOVE INTO THE TESTIMONIAL

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1 SPEAKER: OKAY. AND DOCTOR, DRAWING YOUR ATTENTION TO MEDICAL EXAMINER'S 2 EXHIBIT NO. ONE, THAT IS THE FIRST PAGE OF THE DOCUMENT, WOULD YOU KINDLY 3 READ YOUR SUMMARY OUT LOUD FOR THE COURT 4 5 SPEAKER: THE WHOLE SUMMARY? 6 7 SPEAKER: YES, PLEASE 8 9 SPEAKER: THE FIRST POINT IS 5 TOTAL GUN SHOT WOUNDS, ALL ENTERING THE 10 BACK, THE SECOND, ADDITIONAL TWO GRAZE WOUNDS ARE PRESENT ON THE FORE ARMS, ALONG WITH OTHER SECONDARY FRAGMENT WOUNDS DETAILED BELOW, THE THIRD 11 12 POINT IS ALL 5 GUNSHOT WOUNDS ARE FATAL, NEXT, 500CC OF RIGHT AND 600CC 13 LEFT HEMOTHORAX, NEXT, 250CC CLOTT HUMEIAN PER CARNUMENT, NEXT, 150CC 14 HUMAN PER TONEIUM AROUND THE LIVER, NEXT, ALL BULLETS TRAVELED BACK TO 15 FRONT, AND SLIGHTLY UPWARDS, THROUGH THE TORSO, EXCEPT GUNSHOT WOUND 16 NUMBER ONE WHICH IS SLIGHTLY DOWNWARDS. NEXT IS THREE MUSHROOMED JACKETED 17 MEDIUM CALIBER BULLETS ARE RECOVERED AND SUBMITTED INTO EVIDENCE. A BULLET 18 FRAGMENT WAS RECOVERED FROM THE ABDOMOMAN WAS SEEN. ALL WOUNDS ARE ONE 19 QUARTER INCH ROUND WITH AN ABRASION COLLAR. NEXT, FOR PURPOSES OF 20 IDENTIFICATION AND CONVENIENCE, INJURIES ARE ARBITRARILY NUMBERED, AND 21 THIS IS NOT AN OPINION AS TO THE ORDER IN WHICH THESE WOUNDS WERE 22 SUSTAINED.

IF YOU SEE THAT, THAT IS A CLOSE RANGE WOUND. THE NEXT 22 IS STIPPLING, STIPPLING IS CAUSED BY UNBURNED GUN POWDER, STRIKING THE 23 SKIN. THEY APPEAR AS PIN POINT ABRASIONS AROUND THE GUN SHOT POUND AND 24 THAT SIGNIFIES INTERMEDIATE RANGE WOUND. NEXT IS SEARING, WHERE YOU HAVE A 25 CONTACT CLOSE RANGE WOUND WHERE THE MUZZLE OF THE GUN, THE HEAT FROM THAT,
